

SCHEDULING ORDER

Before the Court is the Parties' Joint Proposed Scheduling Order. The Court held a status conference related to the scheduling order in this case on June 23, 2017 and all parties were represented by counsel. At the hearing, the Court reset the trial date for October 16, 2017 and ordered the parties to agree to a scheduling order with this new trial date, which the parties did prior to leaving the courtroom that day. In consideration of said joint proposed order and the hearing before the court on June 23, 2017, it is hereby ORDERED that the following deadlines shall apply to this case:

1. Fact discovery, including discovery related to Plaintiff's economic loss, shall be completed by July 31, 2017. In the event there is a conflict in scheduling

- depositions by this deadline the parties shall consult to determine an agreeable date.
- 2. The Plaintiff shall identify any experts to be used at trial and submit Rule 26 expert disclosures of their opinion no later than May 30, 2016. The Defendant shall identify any experts to be used at trial and submit Rule 26 expert disclosures no later than June 10, 2017. Plaintiff's expert should be deposed no later than July 17, 2017. Defendants' expert should be deposed no later than July 17, 2017. All Motions to exclude expert witnesses shall be filed by August 8, 2017.
- 3. Depositions are set as follows:
- 4. Clark Cooper -May 25, 2017
- 5. Claiborne Seier May 26, 2017
- 6. John Bullock, Jr May 26, 2017
- 7. Burt Newsome May 30, 2017
- 8. Balch & Bingham, LLP 30(b)(6) June 27, 2017
- 9. Brian Hamilton, Iberia Bank June 27, 2017
- 10. Plaintiff's expert, Veronica Root July 12, 2017
- 11. The parties shall file dispositive motions by August 8, 2017. Plaintiff's response to each Defendant's motion for summary judgment shall be due 28 days after the date of each Defendant's filing of a motion for summary judgment. Defendant's reply is due 14 days thereafter. The Defendant or Plaintiff may call the court to schedule oral argument on the motion for summary judgment, if desired.

- 12. The Parties shall exchange witness and exhibit lists at least 14 days prior to trial. Any witness or exhibit that is not identified shall not be allowed into evidence absent leave of the Court for good cause shown. Any objections to the witness and exhibit lists must be filed no later than 7 days prior to trial.
- 13. Any pre-trial motions shall be filed at least 10 days prior to trial. Any responses to said motions shall be filed at least 7 days prior to trial.

14. Parties shall appear at a call of the trial docket on October 16, 2017 at 9:00 a.m.
